







When and where:

From 8th july - 13th july at Limbjerggård, Bøgedalsvej 20 8680 Ry. We are working on offering accommodation already from the 6th july, so it is possible to partake in the whole JWOC fun. But the official programme is to start on monday 8th july.

What:

YOLA2019 is a training-academy camp for young leaders in Orienteering arranged by the Danish Orienteering Federation in collaboration with the orienteering federations of Estonia, Finland, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway and Sweden.

Number of participants:

Each of the federations can participate with up to 4 young leaders + a YOLA federation coordinator.

Participants fee 340 euros

The fee covers accommodation, full board, transport during the camp and participants fee for the included races of the JWOCTour.

Preliminary programme:

Monday 8th july	Meetup and official start of YOLA2019 at the venue of JWOC
Tuesday 9th july	Long Distance and JWOCTour race. Learning activities and preparations for visit to Puls Skolen and promotion event.
Wedensday 10th july	Excursion to DOF partner Puls Skolen. Puls Skolen is promoting sport to 200 kids aged 8-16 in Silkeborg. Hosting of event for the kids at Puls Skolen.
Thursday 11th july	Spectating at JWOC Middle Final. Participation in JWOCTour. Hosting of promotion event for the public in Silkeborg.
Friday 12th july	Spectating at JWOC Relay. Participation in JWOCTour. YOLA2019 Banquet.
Saturday 13th july	Departure

YOLA federation coordinator

Each federation is expected to appoint a coordinator, who will lead the delegation. The coordinators of the federations will partake in the planning process of the programme, to make sure that the content of YOLA2019 is relevant for all participants. Each federation is expected to contribute with some kind of learning activity during YOLA2019.
